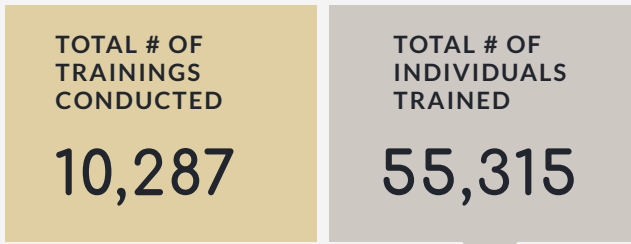

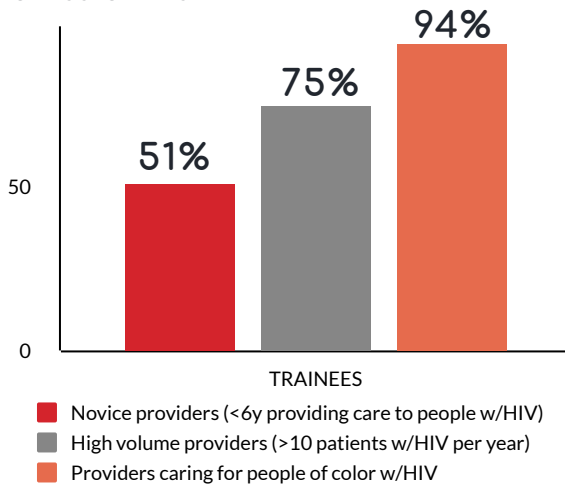

Training Outcomes and Program Reach

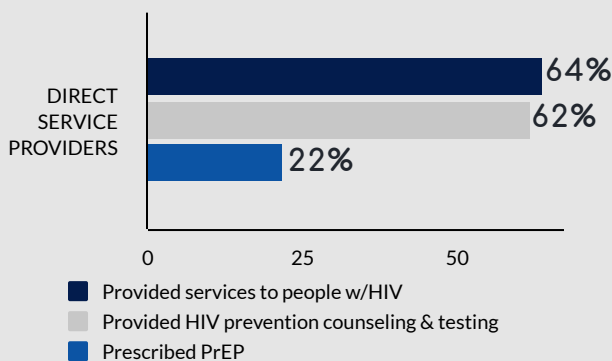


% OF TOTAL HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS TRAINED



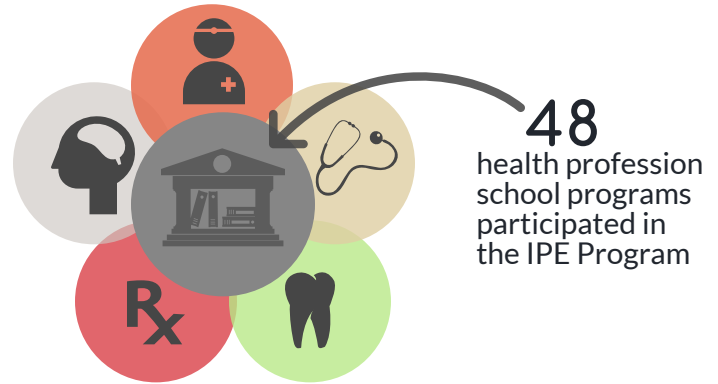
>50% of healthcare professionals trained are people of color

OF 37,003 DIRECT SERVICE PROVIDERS TRAINED



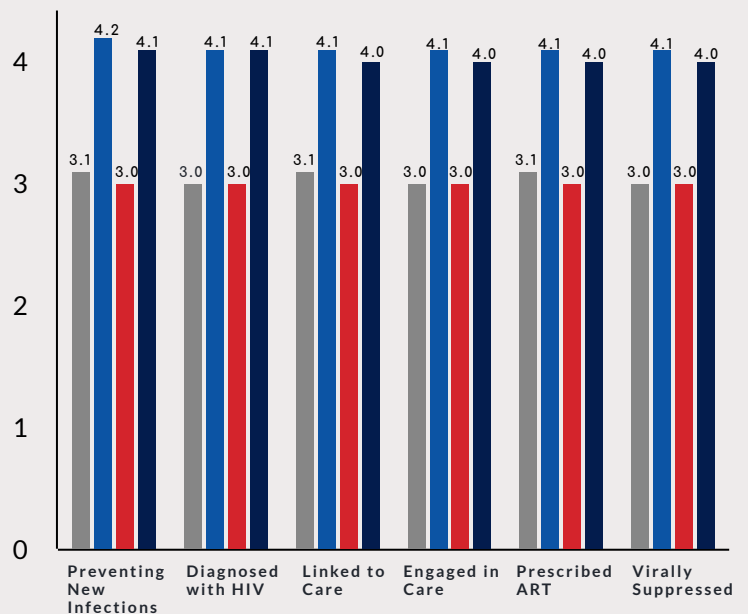
Interprofessional Education (IPE) Program

IPE PROGRAM PREPARES STUDENTS IN MEDICAL, NURSING, DENTAL, PHARMACY, AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAMS TO PROVIDE INTEGRATED HIV CARE



PARTICIPANTS DEMONSTRATED STATISTICALLY SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENTS IN KNOWLEDGE ACROSS THE HIV CARE CONTINUUM FOR MINORITY AIDS INITIATIVE (MAI) AND CORE TRAININGS

MAI pre training MAI post training
CORE pre training CORE post training



Estimated medical savings from HIV prevention = \$230 thousand

1 prevented infection = \$280 million

If 10% of trained prescribers prevented 1 HIV infection = \$2.8 billion

If every prescriber trained by an AETC in 2017-2018 prevented 1 HIV infection = \$2.8 billion
