#### Description

Chemsex, the use of substances before or during sex to enhance or enable the experience, is a prevalent practice in sexual and gender diverse (SGD) people. Evidence-based treatments and safety interventions exist for these substances but are under-utilized due to factors including lack of provider knowledge, drug labeling, and misconceptions regarding the etiology of substance use disorders. In this case-based workshop participants will learn and apply pharmacotherapeutic and counseling interventions for disordered Chemsex use that are supported by clinical research.

#### Learning Objectives

- Formulate an advanced understanding of the etiology and context of Chemsex use disorders using syndemic theory and cultural analysis.
- Apply motivational interviewing and harm reduction methodology to support the wellness of people who participate in Chemsex in an anti-paternalistic way.
- Translate clinical research on treatments for Chemsex substances into therapeutic prescribing practices.
