Description

A local federally qualified health center's (FQHC's) approach to addressing the syndemic - a group of related epidemics - of HIV, HCV, reproductive health, sexual health (STIs), and mental health (including SUD). Solutions include accessible testing, outreach, PrEP support, and harm reduction programming.
